

ABOUT THE TACTICAL OPERATIONS ACADEMY



OVERVIEW

The Tactical Operations Academy is a comprehensive training program that covers a wide range of instruction, from firearms and tactics to executive protection and tactical medicine. Students will learn 88 Tactical's proprietary Behavior-Based Methodology, which focuses on real-world encounters, not textbook hypotheticals. This 30-day academy is taught at 88 Tactical's outdoor training facility in Tekamah, Nebraska.

In addition to receiving 12 credit hours toward their degree at Hocking College, 88 Tactical will provide qualified students with instructor-level certifications in High Threat CQB, High Threat Vehicle Engagements, and TacMed.

REGISTRATION

To attend the first Tactical Operations Academy, students must register by **February 14, 2020**.



The first Tactical Operations Academy will start on March 16, 2020 and run for 30 days.

Post 9/11 GI Bill®

If you have at least 90 days of aggregate active duty service after Sept. 10, 2001, and are still on active duty, or if you are an honorably discharged Veteran or were discharged with a service-connected disability after 30 days, you may be eligible for this VA-administered program.

Qualified applicants will receive up to 36 months of education benefits, generally payable for 15 years following your release from active duty. For details, visit va.gov or try the GI Bill® Comparison Tool on the VA's website.
